(Revised & Enhanced Previous Lesson)

Study Verses: Philippians 4: -9

Paul writes succinctly to the church at Philippi: "Be anxious for nothing: but everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your request be known to God." Admittedly, it will take more faith than what I have today to end all my worrying. Yes, as I've grown in grace over the years, my worry has been scaled down to "healthy concern", or so I would tell you.

The truth is, I always seem to do my serious worrying early on, before giving a problem to the Lord. How absurd is that? I know God's promise, but fail to use it until the Holy Spirit reminds me that the Scriptures clearly explain GOD's willingness to shoulder my burden. I know that! I have experienced that! Why then...

In Paul's Philippian message, he teaches five practical lessons every believer needs. Each point is complete with instructions for living a more abundant life.

- → Rejoice in the Lord...Always!
- → Be Anxious for Nothing
- → The Peace of God is ours...Freely, not Needing Understanding.
- → Concentrate on What is Good and Excellent, Seek Wisdom.
- → Contemplate and Boldly Use the Above Lessons

CLOSE

Upon reading the "Study Verses" listed above, I wish to share a couple of spirit inspired thoughts that have been so helpful to me over the years. I pass them on with the sincere hope they will aid your Christian journey, as they have mine.

Confronting a serious problem, once you understand what you are dealing with...DO NOT CONTINUE TO DWELL ON IT. That is stemming from pure evil (Satan). Worry gives growth to greater trouble, and it becomes more perplexing. Rather, concentrate on the Solution, Jesus Christ! He is greater than any of our problems, and that is who God's Perfect Peace flows from while we await divine action. He may choose to involve us directly, or not at all.

We cannot wear-out our **God** with prayer or praise. Fervent prayer honors Him and aligns us with..."Your will be done." His way is always the best way, the "higher way".


